



Kamp Koinonia 2023

Special Instructions:

It is vital that forms are submitted timely to make all preparations for transportation, meals, and lodging.

Pre-Registration:

1. Register and pay online chcoc.org/events/kamp-2023
2. If camper needs a scholarship, select the **Scholarship Request ticket. The Camp Director will contact you to discuss the amount needed.

Kamp Check-In/Out:

1. Check-in is at Cedar Hill Church of Christ, 535 S Clark Rd, Cedar Hill, 75104 on Sunday June 18 beginning at 12:30p. Parents who unable to check-in their camper at this time can bring their kids up to camp later in the day upon advance notice to the Camp Director.
2. At check-in, your child must be signed in, registration fees paid in full, and forms completed and signed.
3. Upon pick up at the end of the week; your child must be signed out.
4. Transportation is available from church building to and from the camp, just request it on the application.

Dress:

Modest clothing should be worn at all times. Sleeveless shirts are permissible if fitted around the arms and shoulders and covers most of the shoulders. Not permissible: short shorts, mini-skirts, halter tops, spaghetti straps, exposed midriffs, and t-shirts with inappropriate sayings. Staff decisions on the appropriateness of attire should be cheerfully honored.

Specific Items:

1. Campers cannot bring cell phones to camp this year, so they can unplug and focus on the Lord's message.
2. If brought, use of personal devices (e.g., video games) will be limited to specific times of the day to avoid distraction.
3. Prohibited items: Tobacco, drugs, alcohol of any kind, fireworks, matches and lighters.
4. We are not responsible for lost or damaged items.
